**NOTICE OF RULING, JUNE 15, 2022 TRIAL
SETTING CONFERENCE**

1 **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that at the June 15, 2022 Trial Setting Conference, the Court
2 issued the following orders:

3 1. The Court set the matter for trial on May 15, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. in Dept. 10. The Court
4 further noted that the Court will be dark the week of May 22, 2023, and accordingly jury selection will
5 commence the week of May 30, 2023 and the five-week jury trial will commence on May 30, 2023. The
6 Court set the following pre-trial dates:

- 7 a. September 30, 2022 – Simultaneous exchange of supplemental expert reports;
- 8 b. Non-mandatory date between September 30, 2022 and October 28, 2022 for any party to
9 file a motion as to issues regarding expert testimony on damages as addressed by the
10 Court during the Trial Setting Conference;
- 11 c. October 28, 2022 – Simultaneous exchange of rebuttal expert reports;
- 12 d. November 15, 2022 – Expert Discovery to be concluded;
- 13 e. December 5, 2022 – Deadline for parties to file motions pursuant to Evidence Code
14 sections 801 and 802 (“Sections 801 and 802 motions”);
- 15 f. December 22, 2022 – Deadline for parties to file oppositions to Sections 801 and 802
16 motions;
- 17 g. January 18, 2023 – Deadline for parties to file replies in support of Sections 801 and 802
18 motions;
- 19 h. January 31, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. – Hearing on Sections 801 and 802 motions;
- 20 i. February 10, 2023 – Deadline for parties to exchange (1) initial exhibit lists; (2)
21 deposition designations; (3) witness lists; (4) list of motions in limine; (5) statement of the
22 case; (6) initial set of jury instructions; and (7) verdict form. The Court ordered that the
23 parties’ exhibit lists either identify the document by discovery bates numbers or provide a
24 copy of the document in order for the opposing party to know what the proposed exhibit
25 is;
- 26 j. February 17, 2023 – Deadline for the parties to (1) file motions *in limine*; (2) serve
27 objections to other side’s non-agreed jury instructions and deposition designations/
28 counter-designations; (3) trial briefs; (4) agreed and disputed jury instructions with

1 objections and responses; (5) statement of the case; (6) deposition designations with
2 objections; (7) exhibit lists with objections identified in a column that informs the Court
3 as to whether there is an agreement as to the authenticity and admissibility of each exhibit;
4 (8) pre-trial stipulations; and (9) proposed verdict form(s);

5 k. February 28, 2023 – Deadline for parties to (1) file any oppositions to motions *in limine*;
6 and (2) serve responses to the other side’s objections to non-agreed jury instructions;


7 1. March 15, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. – Final Status Conference and hearing on all motions *in*
8 *limine*.

9 2. The Court set a further Status Conference for October 12, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. with Joint
10 Status Report due on October 5, 2022.

11 3. The Court further provided copies of two letters received by the Court from class
12 members and ordered Plaintiffs’ counsel to respond to the correspondence and to file the responses with
13 the Court.
